Bicycle Program	\$7,818	The Christmas Bicycle Give-A-Way Program continues to be a community outreach program where the Sheriff's Office helps underprivileged children. Purchased supplies and parts to fix bikes. Purchased 200 helmets and 40 training wheels to be given away with the bikes. Purchased tools to help in the preparation for fixing the bikes.
Black Lake Services	\$401	Purchase of patrol flashlights for the Sheriff's South Station.
California State Sheriffs' Association Conference (CSSA)	\$99,858	The CSSA Conference was held in April 2014 and hosted by the Sheriff's Office. The majority of the cost for the conference was provided by the California State Sheriff's Association and donations from the general public.
Sponsored Training Program	\$306	General program expenses.
Central Chapter # 73 International Footprinter Association COPS 'KIDS Field Day	\$3,500	Event expenses for T-shirts given away, advertising, food, rentals, and other miscellaneous items. Funding was provided by a PG&E grant.
Gang Resistance Education & Training (GREAT) Program	\$10,032	Expenses for providing three free summer camps for children in North Coast, South County and North County. The camp provided fun games, field trips, professional education in bullying, and gang resistance, alcohol and drug prevention and free food for one week.
PG&E Emergency Preparedness	\$32,972	For the Task Force on Public Safety Public Relations activities, purchased production services for videos/PSAs, Air Public Safety PSAs on KSBY-TV and airtime on American General Mexlin for three radio stations. The purpose is to make San Luis Obispo County the most prepared county in the nation for disaster preparedness.
Search & Rescue	\$1,443	Search & Rescue volunteers attend numerous community events annually. They hand out memorabilia to children at these events. The following items were purchased; 1,200 Skywalker Compasses with Safety Whistles and Lanyard and 57 packs of personalized pencils.
Search & Rescue - Meadows	\$1,305	Search and Rescue use ATVs to provide medical standbys for special events held within the county to augment searches for missing persons and trainings. The current helmets are old, chipped, damaged and in need of replacement. This purchase was requested from a donation by Tim Meadows, whose son died during an ATV accident while responding to a medical aide at the Oceano Dunes. These helmets retail at \$119.95 each, merchant agreed to sell each helmet at \$89.95. Also, purchased five Spider Straps used on spine and extraction boards to provide secure transport of patients.

Sheriff's Family Day at the Ranch	\$10,362	Thousands of people attend the event annually which is free to people of all ages. Its purpose is to give the residents in our community an opportunity to meet law enforcement and public safety personnel as they display their equipment and perform demonstrations. Educational material is provided to help the public to obtain a better understanding of the law enforcement and public safety services available to them and ways to protect themselves against crime and injury. Also, it offers those who are considering public service as a career the chance to speak with other people who are already doing the job. Event expenses are for T-shirts, hot dogs, soft drinks and memorabilia given away to children under 12, and advertising, equipment rentals, and other miscellaneous items.
Sheriff's Mounted Posse	\$603	Purchase of awards, plaques and dinners for Posse volunteers for their dedication and service to the Posse.
Sheriff's Office - Other	\$150	Share in the purchase of flowers for the Police Memorial Ceremony on May 14th in San Luis Obispo County.
Sheriff Range Renovation	\$15,883	Purchase of a permanent shade cover suspended by 5/16 guy wire 20' x 80' wide.
Sheriff's Sponsored Training Program	\$483	General Program Expenses
SLSO-K-9 Unit	\$1,175	Purchased of three gray flush 24"x12" granite grave markers for out deceased Sheriff's K-9s who served the citizens of San Luis Obispo County. Expenses for K-9 training, certifications and purchase of items to build kennels for K-9s.
